4 OPEN FORUM

Mr Dunne representing the Fair Oak Community Library reported on progress so far the library had opened 2021 as a charitable trust and was run by 30 volunteers on a rota basis. They now opened 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ hrs per week and had 750 residents signed up. They also had play group, story time and knit & knatter sessions.

Mrs Painter as a resident since 1966 had seen lots of changes in the area thanking the council for all the work carried out. She felt privileged to be part of the community.

She reported on her 13 year involvements in Trefoil which had raised £1400 for the Motor Neurone Charity last year.. The group were currently recruiting. They were excited to be included in the time capsule.
