- Re-launch expected 12 August.


### Lapstone 2nd Wicket

The planning application is due to be considered by the LAC on 28 June 2023.

There is one objection from the Ramblers
Association because because they are
concerned about directing more school children
onto pavilion close via OHH. As this is a wider
traffic mangement issue it falls outside the scope
of this application

5 resident objections based on location of cricket nets. Residents seem to be under the misunderstanding that these will be located by the tennis courts, They are in fact to be located further away from the houses to the north east of the site.

Plan is for phase 1 of works (cricket pitches, irrigation and nets) to take place in September (had 3 tender returns back end of last week which I'll share in next day or two), Phase 2 (culvert extension, cut and fill works, footpath and landscaping), Spring/early summer 2024



### Crowdhill Play Area Opens

The Play area was completed (inc inspection) and opened on Friday 9 June. Due to the controversy and delay with the play area (not of the Parish's making) a formal launch did not take place. But an ice-cream van made available and first 100 children received free ice-cream. £29,178 left in budget however, still some invoices to pay. Likely to come under budget.



### Pembers POS Update

The Clerk and the Council's Play Area consultant have met with Drew Smith and Eastleigh Borough Council to discuss the setting out of the play area land.

The current plans show pathways through the LEAP which is not appropriate. After approaching EBC to alter this, they have since agreed. Drew Smith will move off the site in October. At which time the 12 months maintenance will begin. It is hoped that the Parish can start community engagement on the play area in the spring along with the public art for the site.
